The Powerline range of high power modules includes half bridge, chopper, dual, single and bi-directional switch configurations covering voltages from 1200V to 6500V and currents up to 2400A.

The DIM400XCM45-TS001 is a single switch 4500V, n-channel enhancement mode, insulated gate bipolar transistor (IGBT) chopper module. The IGBT has a wide reverse bias safe operating area (RBSOA) plus 10µs short circuit withstand. This device is optimised for traction drives and other applications requiring high thermal cycling capability.

The module incorporates an electrically isolated base plate and low inductance construction enabling circuit designers to optimise circuit layouts and utilise grounded heat sinks for safety.




Fig. 1 Circuit configuration




Fig. 3 Typical output characteristics




Fig. 4 Typical output characteristics




Fig. 5 Typical switching energy vs collector current




Fig. 6 Typical switching energy vs gate resistance




Fig. 7 Diode typical forward characteristics




Fig. 8 Reverse bias safe operating area




Fig. 9 Diode reverse bias safe operating area




Fig. 10 Transient thermal impedance




Fig. 11 Module outline drawing
