The Powerline range of high power modules includes half bridge, chopper, dual, single and bi-directional switch configurations covering voltages from 1200V to 6500V and currents up to 2400A.

The DIM1500ASM33-TL001 is a Low  $V_{CE(sat)}$  single switch 3300V, n-channel enhancement mode, insulated gate bipolar transistor (IGBT) module. The IGBT has a wide reverse bias safe operating area (RBSOA) plus 10 $\mu$ s short circuit withstand. This device is optimised for traction drives and other applications requiring high thermal cycling capability.

The module incorporates an electrically isolated base plate and low inductance construction enabling circuit designers to optimise circuit layouts and utilise grounded heat sinks for safety.

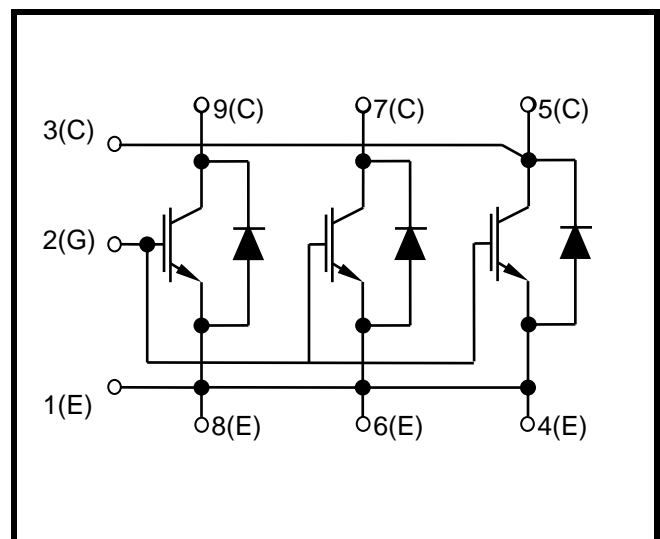
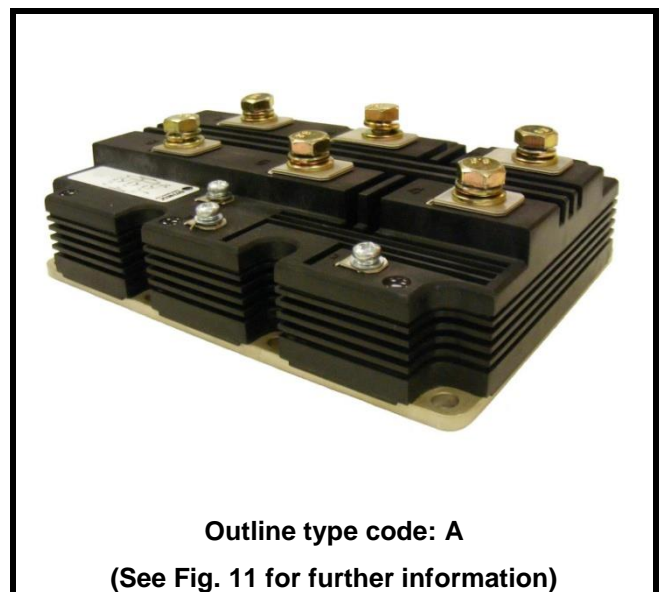


Fig. 1 Circuit configuration

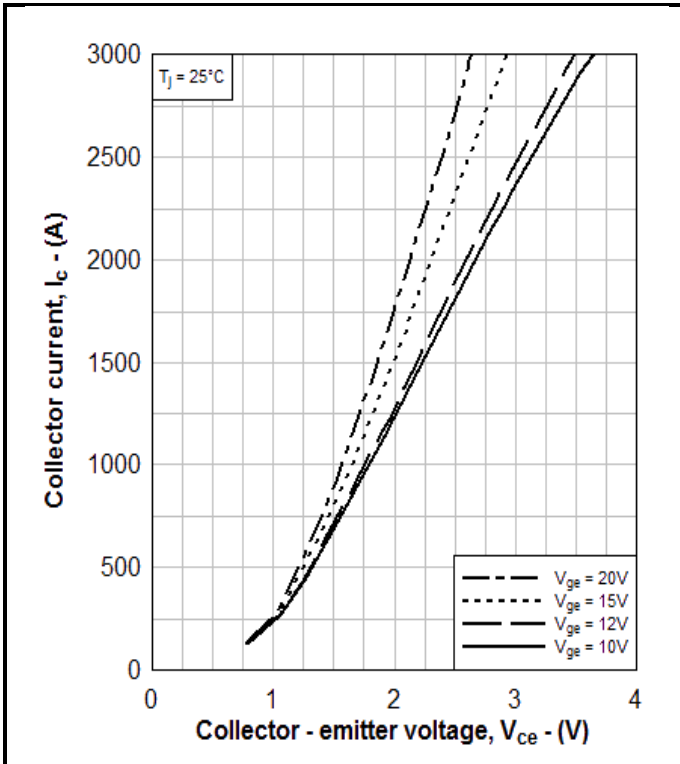

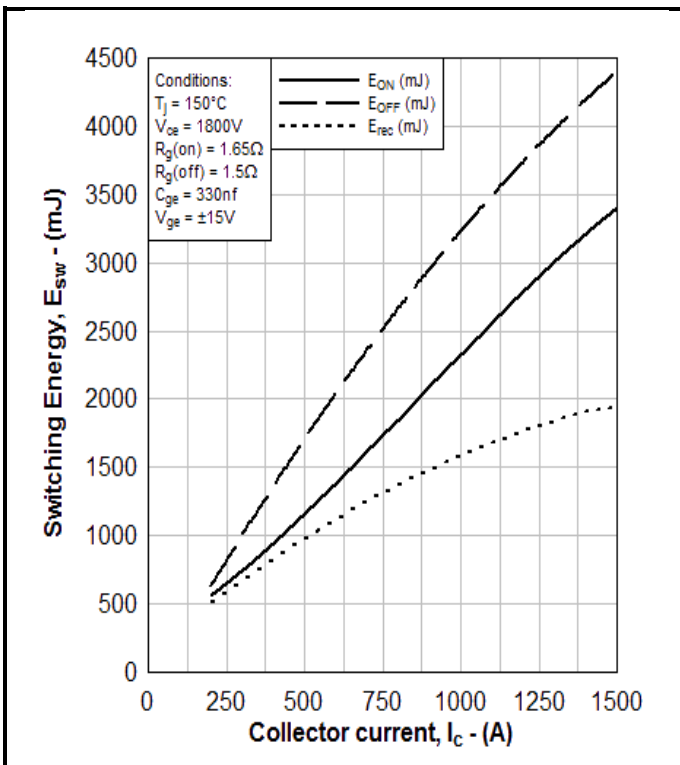

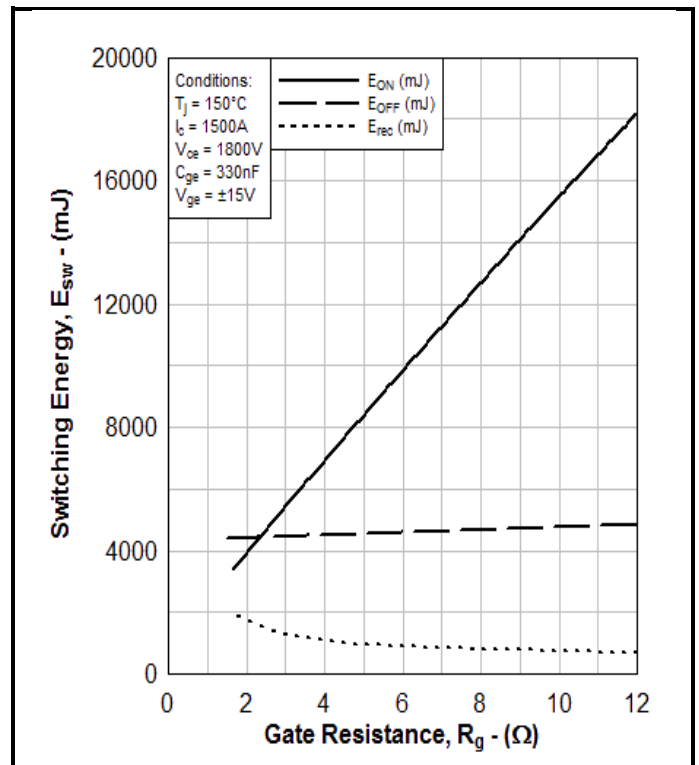
**Fig. 3 Typical output characteristics**

**Fig. 6 Typical switching energy vs gate resistance**

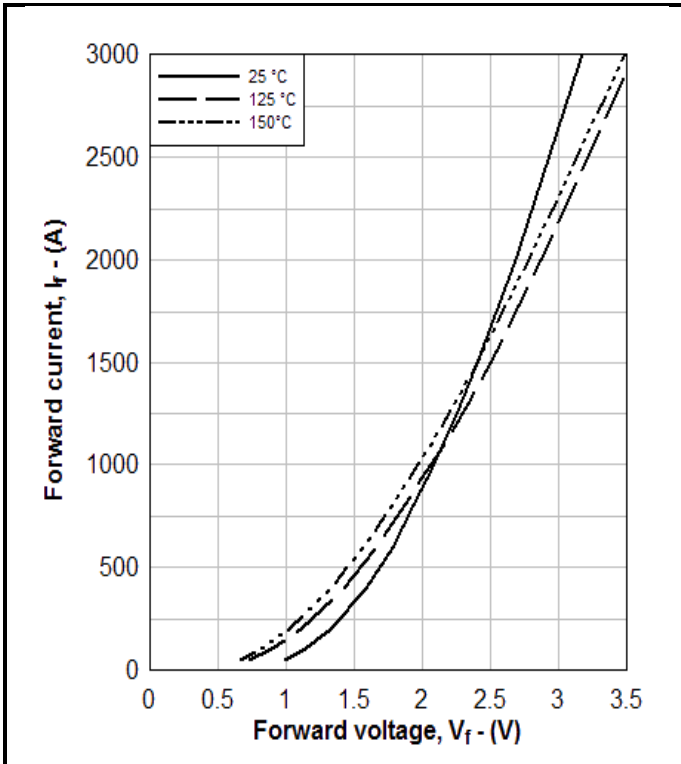


Fig. 7 Diode typical forward characteristics

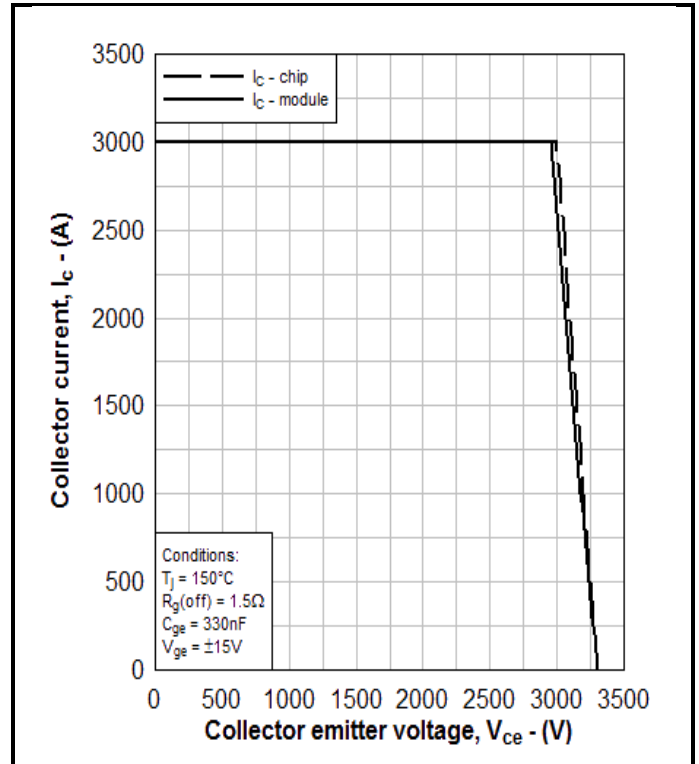


Fig. 8 Reverse bias safe operating area

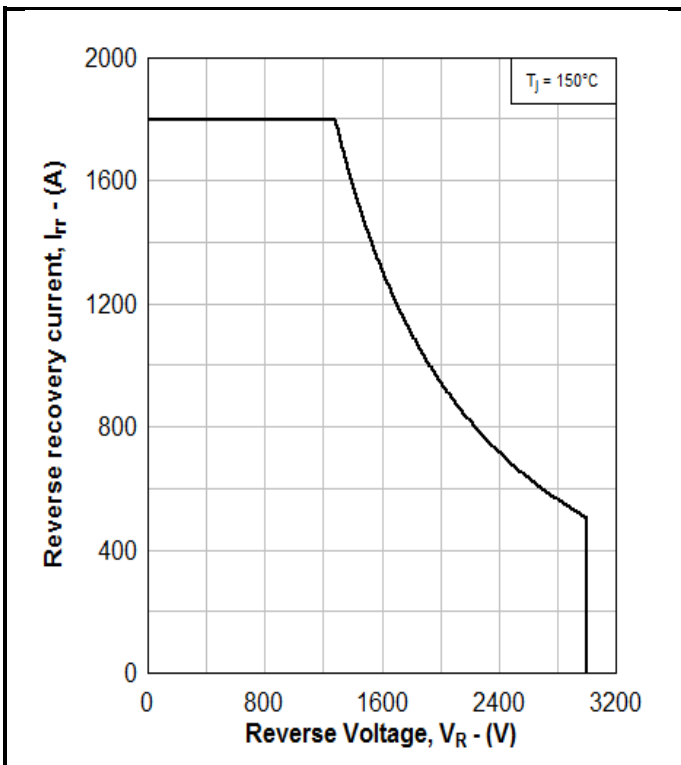


Fig. 9 Diode reverse bias safe operating area

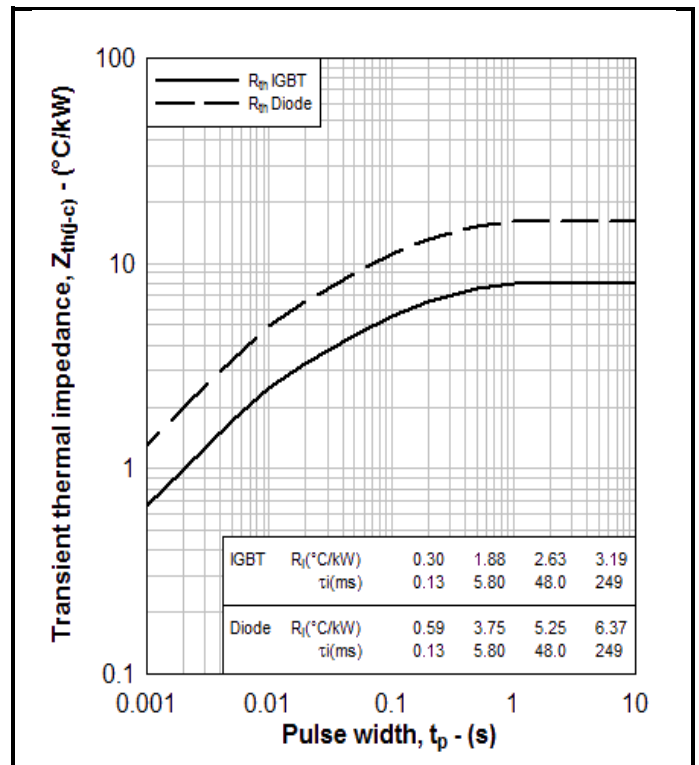
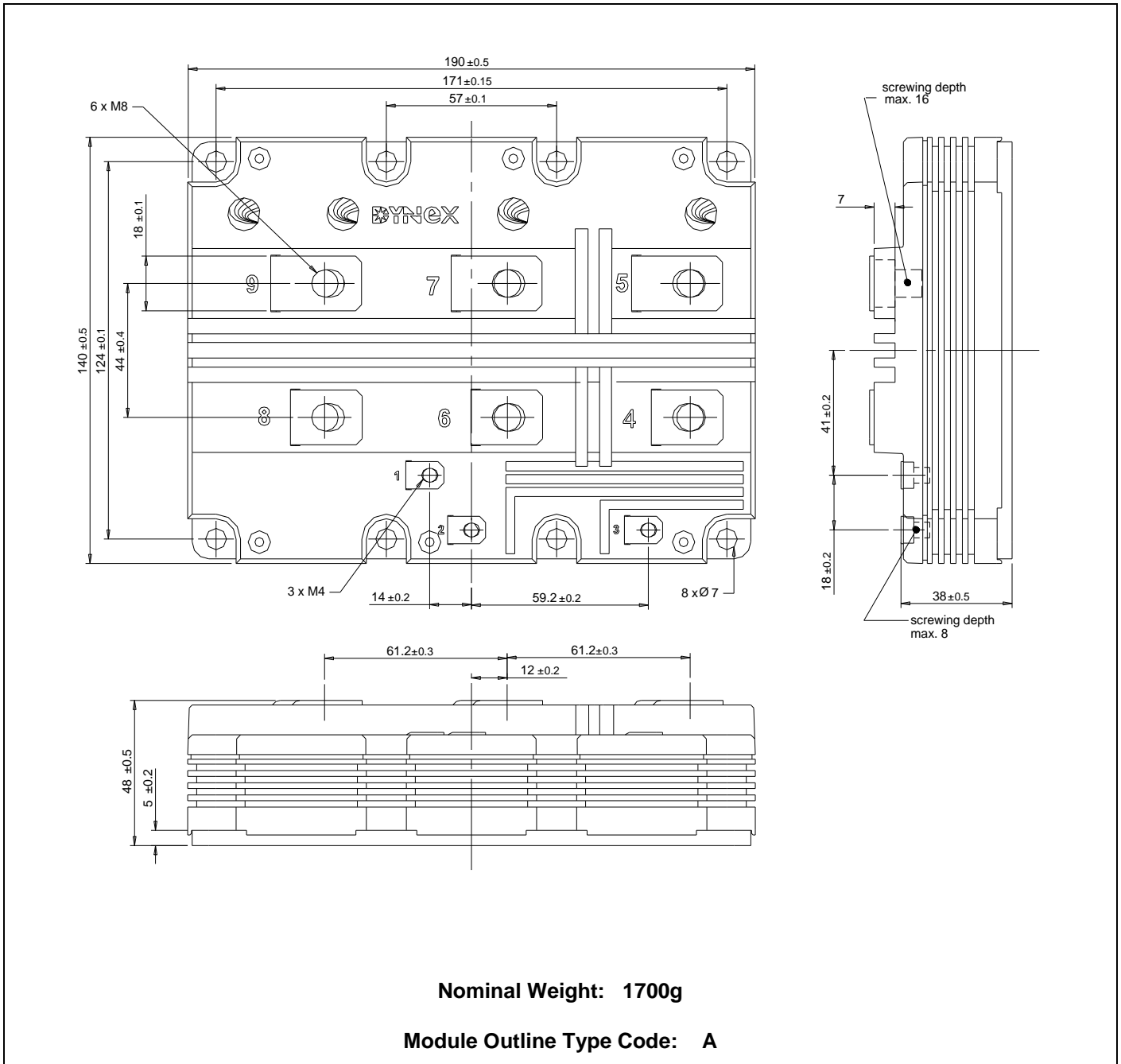


Fig. 10 Transient thermal impedance
